1. User Sessions in Access & Security

A security feature has been added to the Access & Security tab of the Personal Settings console. The new section, 'Currently Signed In', displays all concurrent user sessions of the user. Not only can the user see if the system is accessed from an unknown IP address or on an unknown device, but it is also possible to immediately revoke that access.

1 of 1: Approving and Rejecting With Required Fields

We have changed the behavior of the **Thumb up** and **Thumb down** buttons in approval tasks in Xurrent Self Service. Heretofore, when a note- or custom field that is required for approval or rejection was not yet populated, the buttons were grayed out until the data was entered. Now, the buttons are active (in green and red) and the validation is done afterwards, just as in the Specialist Interface.
